OUR MISSION:

Student council is a group of individuals responsible for both social and governmental aspects of student life at CCHS. We are involved with planning dances and spirit weeks, helping with services such as the blood drive, taking care of student concerns, and helping to decide where the money in the student activities' fund gets spent.

In the past, student council has been a popularity contest. It is no longer so. We are a serious organization that has a lot of responsibilities and power in our hands which we must use for the good of the student body. We only want people who are committed to working hard, attending meetings, running small committees, and participating in student council sponsored activities. REQUIREMENTS:

To run for student council, there are some requirements that need to be met:

- ❑ GRADES:
 - Eighth graders must have no F's
 - Freshmen, sophomores, and juniors must have a GPA of at least 2.5.
- ❑ DISCIPLINE:
 - No continuous disciplinary problems are allowed
 - If there are signs of attendance, behavioral, or truancy issues, student will not be allowed to run for office.
- ❑ INVOLVEMENT:

- We want students who like being involved in our community; therefore we require that you be involved in at least 2 Extra-curricular activities (youth group at church, 4-H, music lessons, sports, speech, etc.)
- We also reserve the right to require not only attendance, but active participation in student council activities to keep your position on the council. Students not meeting expectations will be asked to leave the group.
- **STUDENT BODY & STAFF SUPPORT:**
 - You need to be someone your classmates respect and trust. You also need to be able to cooperate and work with teachers and administrators. To prove that you have support, on the application attached to this letter, you must collect the signatures of 30 kids in your grade, 3 teachers who support your nomination, and 2 administrators who verify that you are a quality person.

All of the applications will undergo a screening process by the present student council to insure that you have met all the requirements. If requirements are met, then your name will be put on the ballot for student council representative. We will hold the election around the end of May.

Applications are due by TUESDAY May26th, with voting taking place on May 28th.
