

Hello and welcome to the new Columbia City High School. This is one of a series of instructional videos to help the community get comfortable with the new building. We are very excited to get the school year started. If you are a parent or guardian that drops off a student in the morning, please take a few minutes to familiarize yourself with the current plan for student drop off. We ask you for your patience and understanding while we determine the safest way to get students in the building. As you enter the campus from state road 9, please enter the main drive that leads to the front entrance. As you enter the main drive, please notice the orange safety cones. We ask that you move into 2 lines similar to what you see at drive through restaurants. As you move closer to the main entrance, and begin to make the turn you will alternate into a single file line again. Please notice the yellow safety cones that say Student Drop Off on them. Please pull up as far as you can and then drop your student off. Once you have dropped your student off, enter whichever turn lane you wish to exit from ,either heading back to state road 9 or south towards County Road 200S. Please keep in mind that student drivers will be entering and exiting their parking areas from the main drive so at times there may be congestion. Adjustments to traffic patterns may be necessary after we start the year. We will communicate any changes with you.
